- Procedures for officers involved in critical incidents
- Jurisdiction issues for emergency incidents, such as pursuits
- Emergency transportation/escort of sick, injured persons
- Officer exposure incidents
- Responding to emergencies when working off-duty jobs, grant overtime, specified details, etc
- On scene procedures at emergency situations
- Other issues as they apply to conflict resolution during emergency incidents
